To promote responsible breeding, all of our puppies registered with the American Kennel Club and are sold with the Limited Registration option. Limited Registration means that the dog is registered with the AKC, however, any offspring produced by the dog would not be eligible to be registered with the AKC. This does not mean that the dog is of lesser quality. Most puppies purchased from our kennel are purchased as companion dogs by owners who have no interest in breeding or showing; therefore, a limited registration will have no bearing on these dogs and their owner.

We do require a contract with our puppy buyers in order to guarantee the safety of the dog. The price of our Irish Terrier puppy adoption will include all sets of puppy vaccinations, all physical exams by our veterinarian before adoption, and the puppy's AKC registration.
